

COVID-19 Vaccine Phase 2 Update

Dear Valued Member,

As per our previous communication, Kaelo will fund all qualifying Members and their Dependants for the COVID-19 vaccine and send targeted information to the qualifying individuals that fall into phase two of the vaccination rollout.

The Department of Health announced that from 16 April 2021, the Electronic Vaccination Data System (EVDS), will be available to phase two qualifying individuals stating with people over the age of 60 years to register for the COVID-19 vaccine.

IMPORTANT COVID-19 VACCINE ROLLOUT UPDATE



Registration for the vaccine via the EVDS Self Registration Portal will be open to the public from 16 April 2021

Vaccines will be rolled out from 17 May (phase two) and 17 October (phase three). Phase two from 17 May will include:

- People over 60 years of age
- Those living in congregate settings eg. old age homes and prisons
- Workers over 40 years of age this is intended to catch most of those living with co-morbidities
- Essential workers



Use the QR code to access the EVDS Self Registration portal and download the User Guide for detailed information on how to register.

To register for the vaccine, follow the steps below:

- 1. Register on the EVDS portal.
- 2. Once registered you will receive a confirmation SMS.
- 3. When you become eligible to be vaccinated, in accordance with the three Phase rollout plan as stipulated by government, you will be issued with a date, time and venue of where you can receive the vaccine. If you are required a second dose, you will be sent another SMS with the relevant information.
- 4. Once you have been vaccinated, you will receive a final SMS with confirmation.
- 5. Please note that vaccination is voluntary.
